Minutes of 1-26-08 were approved, Matt having so moved and Lee seconded.

Sharptown Park Design: We welcomed our guest and discussed benefits of working with CLC.

Lee will give Joyce a tour of the Sharptown site after the meeting.

Joyce provided us with copies of site specific soil maps, pavilion design ideas, contact info about local contractors to ask for estimates and advice.

There was discussion of the issue about which land appraisal value---before or after the conservation easement-- to use for the Grant match. Sean will be in contact with OPR's Ron Rader for a determination. The conservation easement lowered the appraisal from \$285,000 to \$104,000.

Roz is pursuing a site plan estimate from Clark, Crawford Assoc. for a site plan ---\$2-3,000 is expected.

New fencing estimate is needed from Skyview. Joyce suggested that post and rail can be installed by volunteers and that posts and rails run\$10 each. This might be a more rustic and attractive alternative to chainlink.

Kazmo presented a letter of support from Roe-Jan **Soccer** League

Roz has a letter from the Northern Columbia Little League and an enthusiastic verbal promise of a similar letter from neighbor Warren Mistler of the Crane Soccer Club.

Storm water Discharge Permit: Joyce advised to apply early as its a lengthy process. She offered contact info.

Lee/Roz will contact excavators for prices on grading and preparing the front field for ball fields. Lee is meeting with architect Rob Whitlock on 2-17-08 to tour the Sharptown site. Rob has offered to help with pavilion design.

Estimated prices are being gathered to present at the Town Board Meeting on 2-14-08. Sean has volunteered to write it up. (Thanks, Sean!) We are hopeful that the Greenway Committee's idea for a public informational meeting regarding the Sharptown Park will be supported and that a date will be set soon.

Petition goal is 200 signatures.
