Discussion opened by Mr. Folmsbee concerning a need for a revised hunting plan for hunt the KEH Memorial park. Mr Folmsbee presented his view of this fall's hunting and there was much discussion around possible regulations etc. The committee proposed dedicating its March meeting to hunting issues and plans to invite the supervisor and board members as well as interested town residents. Ms. Jamison will put together some hunting material she has gathered from surrounding towns and the committee will prepare a draft suggested policy to be distributed to board members before the March meeting.

Plans for the Moonlight Walk at the K H Memorial park discussed- Michelle researched snowshoe possibilities and has some information on discounts, she has prepared a flyer and is taking signups- K. Schneider has agreed to lead an owl walk, we plan a bonfire and hot cocoa. Walk to begin at 7 pm. on January 10.

Sean reported Grant announcements have been put off until the middle of December. There are indications that only 6 to 8% of the money will be awarded.

Sean also reported that the bluebird houses are up at the K H Memorial park - done with the help of Steve Krizar, Bill Burka, Ron Knott and the boy scouts.

The committee plans to rebuild the Falls playground ice rink on Dec 20 at 9am volunteers welcome!
