

**TOWN OF STUYVESANT
LOCAL LAW #1 OF 2015
INCREASING THE TERM OF OFFICE OF THE TOWN SUPERVISOR**

§ 1. Statutory authority.

This local law is adopted pursuant to the provisions of the Municipal Home Rule Law Sections 10 and 23 of the State of New York and New York Town Law § 24-a.

§ 2. Increase in term of office.

The term of office of the elected Supervisor shall be four years. Such four-year term shall commence as of the first day of January 2018, and shall apply to the person elected to such office at the biennial Town election to be held on November 4, 2017, and to those elected thereafter, provided a proposition submitted pursuant to § 3 below is approved.

§ 3. Mandatory referendum.

This local law is adopted subject to a mandatory referendum and shall be submitted for approval of the qualified voters of the Town of Stuyvesant at the Biennial town election to be held on November 3, 2015. A proposition in the following form shall be included on the ballot at such biennial Town election, and the increased term of office shall not take effect unless such proposition is approved by a majority vote of the qualified voters voting thereon:

"Shall Local Law No. 1, 2015, entitled a Local Law Increasing the Term of Office of the Stuyvesant Supervisor from Two to Four Years be approved?"

§ 4. Supersession of statute.

This local law shall supersede Town Law § 24 relating to the term of office for the Supervisor of the Town of Stuyvesant.
